The PEICC has a new office and mini-gallery space at 39 University Ave, 2nd floor (above Beanz Café). Displays of products will be the primary focus of the gallery space with several display pedestals and shelves and racks available for member product display. Part of the space will display product samples for a variety of members, and the rest of the space will be used for Solo Exhibitions of member products. This space will be provide for one month periods in off- season, and two week periods during summer season. There is no charge for this display space, however it is available or juried members of the PEICC only. Space is allocated on a first come first served basis, so register soon.

YEAR ROUND DISPLAYS: Gateway Village is the only display area open to the public year round for the use of members who have had their work accepted under PEICC Standards Guidelines, and have *similar* product available for sale at their own studio or other outlets. Product should be accompanied by member's business card and/or relevant information on where the items are available.

This case has proven to be an excellent and cost efficient form of visual advertising that provides public exposure to the quality handcrafts produced by PEICC members. Even in the off-season, the awareness is still there.

Display cases are booked on a first-come/first-served basis. Fees are used to cover wages, mileage, long distance phone calls and display material. Please note: The PEICC no longer provides insurance coverage for theft due to break-in or loss through fire. Check with your own company if you wish to ensure protection of your products.
